They share their habitat with other animals like eagles, foxes, and bears, which are their main predators. To stay safe, they use a system of loud whistles to warn each other about danger, earning them the nickname 'whistle pigs'.



Speaking of 'whistle pigs', humans have a pretty cool relationship with these furry creatures. We mostly leave them alone, but sometimes, we're lucky enough to spot them while hiking or camping.
