Lana had \$5.00 when she went to the store. If she bought 1 hat what is the most expensive item she can buy with the money she has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$3.30 = \$1.70$$

coloring book	\$1.05

Gwen had \$5.00 when she went to the store. If she bought 1 figurine what is the most expensive item she can buy with the money she has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$2.50 = \$2.50$$

- 5) The table below shows the prices of several items at the santa store.

Item	Price
candy cane	\$1.70
card	\$2.10
music box	\$3.70
ornament	\$2.80
bow	\$1.50

Carol had \$5.00 when she went to the store. If she bought 1 candy cane what is the most expensive item she can buy with the money she has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$1.70 = \$3.30$$

- 6) The table below shows the prices of several items at a movie theater.

Item	Price
soda	\$2.75
nachos	\$3.45
candy	\$1.95
water	\$3.80
popcorn	\$3.15

Will had \$5.00 when he went to the theater. If he bought 1 soda what is the most expensive item he can buy with the money he has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$2.75 = \$2.25$$
