- 1) Oliver was placing his spare change into stacks. Each stack had ninety-two coins. If he had twenty-seven stacks, how many coins did he have all together?
- 2) A bouquet of flowers had seventy-two daisies in it. If a florist had sixty-seven bouquets, how many daisies did they have total?
- 3) Billy was packing up his old toys. He managed to squeeze eighty toys into a box. If Billy filled up forty-six boxes, how many toys did he pack total?
- 4) At the carnival there are thirty-one students selling tickets. If each student sells fourteen tickets, how many tickets would be sold all together?
- 5) If an industrial machine could make sixty-four erasers in a second, how many erasers would it have made in thirty-five seconds?
- 6) There are fifty-five pieces of popcorn in a small bag. If a movie theater sells sixty-seven small bags, how many pieces of popcorn would they have sold?
- 7) Faye was drawing on scrap paper. She could fit seventy-three drawings on each page. If she has fifty-six pieces of paper, how many drawings can she make?
- 8) An airplane compartment can hold twelve pieces of luggage. If a small plane had sixty-nine compartments, how many pieces of luggage could they hold?
- 9) Will was helping his mom plant vegetables in the garden. Together they planted twelve rows of vegetables with eighty-four seeds in each row. How many seeds did they plant total?
- 10) There are seventy-one teams in the state trivia tournament. If each team has eighty-two players, how many players are there total?
- 11) A laundry mat owner washed sixty-six loads of towels with ninety-one towels in each load. How many towels did he wash total?
- 12) Victor's mother had eighty-eight photo albums with thirty-five pictures in each album. How many pictures did his mother have total?
