2) In a month, a video store rented out 110 action movies and 872 other types of movies. To the nearest ten, what is the sum of the movies they rented in a month?	<u>ten</u> $110 + 870$ 980	<u>hundred</u> $110 + 872$ $982 = 980$	2. <u>980</u>
3) Two friends were counting the number of texts they sent in a month. Alex sent 468 and Jessie sent 223. To the nearest hundred, what is the combined amount of texts they sent?	<u>ten</u> $500 + 200$ 700	<u>hundred</u> $468 + 223$ $691 = 700$	3. <u>700</u>
4) Edward was playing games at the arcade. He won 398 tickets from the basketball game and 397 tickets from whack-a-mole. To the nearest ten, how many tickets did he get total?	<u>ten</u> $400 + 400$ 800	<u>hundred</u> $398 + 397$ $795 = 800$	4. <u>800</u>
5) During a 'Super Saturday Sale', a shoe store sold 338 pairs of sneakers and 484 pairs of sandals. To the nearest ten, what is the total number of shoes the store sold?	<u>ten</u> $340 + 480$ 820	<u>hundred</u> $338 + 484$ $822 = 820$	5. <u>820</u>
6) While playing a trivia game, Team A scored 995 points and Team B scored 943 points. To the nearest hundred, how many points were scored total?	<u>ten</u> $1000 + 900$ 1900	<u>hundred</u> $995 + 943$ $1938 = 1900$	6. <u>1,900</u>
7) The classes in the fourth grade were counting the fundraiser money they earned. Mr. Smith's Class earned 356 dollars and Mrs. White's class earned 662 dollars. To the nearest ten, how much did they earn total?	<u>ten</u> $360 + 660$ 1020	<u>hundred</u> $356 + 662$ $1018 = 1020$	7. <u>1,020</u>
8) Amy was downloading apps to her phone. The first app she downloaded was 324 kb and the second was 274 kb. To the nearest hundred, what was the total size (in kb) of all the apps she downloaded?	<u>ten</u> $300 + 300$ 600	<u>hundred</u> $324 + 274$ $598 = 600$	8. <u>600</u>
9) Victor was playing his favorite video game. In the first round he scored 127 points and in round two he scored 256 points. To the nearest hundred, how many points did he score total?	<u>ten</u> $100 + 300$ 400	<u>hundred</u> $127 + 256$ $383 = 400$	9. <u>400</u>
10) In one day, a mail truck gave out 899 letters and 827 magazines. To the nearest ten, how many pieces of mail did was delivered total?	<u>ten</u> $900 + 830$ 1730	<u>hundred</u> $899 + 827$ $1726 = 1730$	10. <u>1,730</u>
