- 2) Adam's mother had ninety-five photo albums with thirty-three pictures in each album. How many pictures did his mother have total?
- 3) A library checks out thirty-eight books each day. How many books would they have checked out after forty-three days?
- 4) Janet had twenty-nine shelves of DVDs. If each shelf had twenty-four movies on it, how many movies did she have total?
- 5) A teacher had thirty-four students in her classes. If each student completed twenty-five problems, how many problems would she have to grade?
- 6) A delivery driver made exactly sixteen stops each day. After sixty days, how many stops would he have made total?
- 7) An orchard owner was counting the number of apples he had total. Each of his eleven trees had seventy-six apples in it. How many apples did he have total?
- 8) Mike was building a LEGO tower. He built it eighty-two stories tall with sixty-two LEGOs on each story. How many LEGOs did he use total?
- 9) If an industrial machine could make fifty-three erasers in a second, how many erasers would it have made in seventy seconds?
- 10) A bouquet of flowers had thirty-two daisies in it. If a florist had thirty bouquets, how many daisies did they have total?
- 11) Will was placing his spare change into stacks. Each stack had thirty-three coins. If he had fifty-six stacks, how many coins did he have all together?
- 12) Jerry was helping his mom plant vegetables in the garden. Together they planted sixty-one rows of vegetables with fifty-nine seeds in each row. How many seeds did they plant total?
